Who Qualifies?*

- ✓ Currently have no food at home or will run out before you can buy more
- ✓ Can't afford paid meal or grocery delivery
- ✓ Are experiencing financial, social or medical hardships due to COVID-19
- ✓ Have someone at home who is able to prepare food

What should qualifying households expect?

Will receive a grocery box with enough non-perishable food for 1-2 weeks depending on household size

Will receive a box within 3-4 days of ordering

*If you don't qualify for home delivery, you can still get food assistance. Visit:
